

STEPS TO BECOME AN EXCHANGE STUDENT

1. Official Nomination: The international Office of your home University must nominate you through our system „Mobility Online“ taking into account our nomination deadlines:

- Winter Semester: May 15th.
- Summer Semester: December 15th.

2. Application: Once you are nominated, you get access to Mobility Online, where you can fill out all the required information and upload the documents:

- Transcript of records
- Language Certificate (at least B2)
- Passport style Picture
- Copy of Passport or ID
- University entrance qualification (e.g. highschool diploma)
- CV

Make sure to complete your application carefully. Contact us if you have any questions or if you need support in the process.

3. Learning Agreement: As soon as your application is complete, the International Office can approve it, so that you can upload your Learning Agreement, which must be reviewed and approved by both universities.

4. Prepare your arrival: Once your Learning Agreement is approved, you can start planning your stay in Landshut! Check our student guide for all further informations (visa, health insurance, bank account,..).

5. Welcome Landshut:

LANDSHUT

Landshut is a city full of history and charm. It was founded in 1204 by Duke Ludwig I of Bavaria. Every four years, the so called „Landshuter Hochzeit,“ takes place. It is one of the biggest European historical festivals. Moreover, Landshut is home to the iconic Trausnitz Castle (see picture) and the St. Martin’s Church, with the tallest brick tower in the world. The ancient ducal town is located in the heart of Lower Bavaria by the river Isar and close to Bavaria’s capital city, Munich.

STUDENT UNION FEE

All students must pay the so-called tuition fee once per semester. This currently amounts to 125,62 €. This is an administrative fee that covers the student service fee and the semester ticket for public transportation in the MVV public transport system. This entitles students to use all bus lines in the Landshut area, as well as tram, train, subway, and suburban train connections in the Munich area.

GETTING AROUND

Landshut is located only 30 minutes by car from Munich’s Franz-Josef-Strauß airport (MUC), and 45-50 minutes by train from Munich’s Central Train Station. In general, you can go to Landshut by train, car or bus. There is a convenient direct train connection from the airport in Munich to Landshut Central Station. The easiest way to move around the city is with the bus, which is free of charge for students.

STUDENT HOUSING

The „Studentenwerk Niederbayern/Oberpfalz“ runs several student dormitories in Landshut. Most rooms are single rooms with own shower/ WC, refrigerator and oven. Some rooms have a shared kitchen and bathroom. You can apply for a room in the dormitory via the International Office during the application process.

BUDDY PROGRAMME

Get a Buddy who helps you with everyday questions such as “where can I buy a bike or where can I get a German Mobile Phone contract?” Your buddy can pick you up upon arrival and supports you throughout your whole study period in Landshut. STRENGTHEN YOUR NETWORK

The International Office as well as the student clubs organize cultural activities throughout the semester. There are student-led clubs and sport teams. Furthermore, we offer intercultural dinners and visits to different cities.
